This is a list of what Nora will be using:

# **PAPER**

9x12" or 12x16" Fluid Brand Hot-Pressed Paper
If you think now is the time to try Hot-Pressed Paper, great.
If not, Cold-Pressed is fine too.
(Nora does NOT recommend the Arches brand of Hot-Pressed watercolour paper).

## **PAINT**

Winsor & Newton or Holbein Tube Paints.
All paints are squeezed out before the first class and allowed to dry.

Yellow Ochre
Cadmium Yellow Light
Alizarin Crimson
Cadmium Red

Cerulean Blue

Ultramarine Blue

Burnt Sienna

Nora also uses Opera Pink and Burnt Umber

# **PALETTE**

A folding plastic palette with big mixing areas Please squeeze out your tube paints the night before the first class.

### **BRUSHES**

Silver Black Velvet 3000S - Sizes 6, 8 and 10 rounds.

Deserres Zen Royal & Langnickel Brushes Z73R - pointy/sizes 8-12 (only \$5 each!)

(Just bring your good quality watercolour brushes).

4B-6B pencils

White paper towels, spray bottle, water container (optional)
