

WATERCOLOUR SUPPLY LIST

PAPER - 9x12" Fluid Brand Watercolour Paper Block. Any good quality watercolour paper will work. Blocks are nice because the sides are 'gummed' down which makes wet-in-wet painting easier.

WATERCOLOUR PAINTS - I use Winsor&Newton Paints: Yellow Ochre Lemon Yellow (or Cad Yellow Light) Cadmium Red light Permanent Rose (or Alizarin Crimson) Opera Pink (fun neon pink) - optional Cerulean Blue Ultramarine Blue Burnt Sienna

PALETTES - A palette with a lot of mixing spaces. I use a plastic folding palette which is nice since it closes and protects the paint.

BRUSHES - Sizes 6-10. Decent quality watercolour brushes. Deserres sells a watercolour brush brand called Zen and they are only about \$5 each. They're good watercolour brushes.

BOARD - to tape watercolour paper to (if you didn't buy a block, which is gummed down at the sides).

PENCILS - 4B

OTHER - Water container, paper towels, masking tape (for paper on boards), spray bottle and kneaded gum erasers.
