

Material List for Further Exploration in Acrylic

- 1 sheet of larger paper (bristol board works well) suitable for using markers and/or pencils
- 1 pad of paper suitable for wet media: can be watercolour, mixed media or acrylic. Should be around 18" x 24"
- Fine black marker (Sharpie works well)
- Drawing pencil, any one of the following will work B, 2B, 4B
- Variety of brushes for acrylic paint, from fine to large (at least 1 that is 3" or 4")
- A variety of palette knives
- Other utensils for pushing paint around such as squeegees, trowels etc.
- Acrylic paint: minimum of 6 colours (make sure to vary your values from light to dark), plus a good supply of black and white
- Palette (pad of palette paper is the most convenient)
- Roll of paper towels
