

WATERCOLOUR SUPPLY LIST Nora MacPhail

PAPER - 9x12" Fluid Brand Watercolour Paper Block. Any good quality watercolour paper will work. (Blocks are nice because the sides are 'gummed' down which makes wet-in-wet painting easier). I use hot-pressed paper but bring what you're comfortable with.

WATERCOLOUR PAINTS - 8 COLOURS
Winsor & Newton Artist Quality Paints or Holbein Paints

Yellow Ochre
Lemon Yellow (or Cad Yellow Light)
Cadmium Red light
Permanent Rose (or Alizarin Crimson)
Cerulean Blue
Ultramarine Blue
Burnt Sienna.
OPTIONAL - Opera Pink (fun neon pink)

PALETTES - A palette with a lot of mixing spaces. I use a plastic folding palette which is nice since it closes and protects the paint.

BRUSHES - Sizes 6-10. Decent quality watercolour brushes. Synthetic brushes are great.

BOARD - to tape watercolour paper to (if you didn't buy a block, which is gummed down at the sides).

PENCILS - 2B or 4B

OTHER - Water container, paper towels, masking tape (for paper on boards), spray bottle and kneaded gum eraser.
